Fine Free and Fine Forgiveness Month at New Library

Fergus Falls, MN – January 2019 – The remodeled and expanded Fergus Falls Public Library opens on Tuesday, January 22 at 205 E. Hampden Library (the intersection of Cascade and Vernon Streets). The Public Library will waive overdue fines for patrons who visit the newly remodeled and expanded library during the first month of reopening. This waiver includes any overdue fines that accrue during that month as well as any overdue fines accrued in the past—no matter how old. The waiver does not include replacement fees for lost items that have not been returned.

If you'd like, bring along an item that can be donated to the Fergus Falls Food Shelf, Otter Tail County Humane Society or a gently used children's book in exchange for the waiver.

Did you know? The Fergus Falls Public Library does not charge overdue fines on children's materials (excluding DVDs) checked out on a child's card. There is no minimum age to get a card for your child and it's free.

The Fergus Falls Public Library is a department of the City of Fergus Falls and a member of the Viking Library System. The library is open Monday through Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
