

Read Library eBooks on your Kindle

You will need

- A computer or mobile device with internet access
- Your library card

Steps

1. On your computer or mobile device, go to **amazon.com** and sign into your account.
2. Go to **ffpubliclibrary.org/digital** and click on **OverDrive Media Console**.
3. When you find a title that you want to check out, click on the book cover and then **Borrow**. If it says **Place a Hold**, all copies are checked out. You can place a hold on the item and be notified by email when it is ready.
4. If prompted, sign into your account and then click **Borrow** again.
5. Go to **My Account** and then select **Checkouts**. Next to the book click **Choose a Format** and select **Kindle Book**. Click **Get Kindle Book**.
6. This opens Amazon. Choose the Kindle you would like the book delivered to and click **Get Library Book**.
7. If your Kindle is connected to Wi-Fi, the book will automatically download.
8. If your Kindle is not connected to Wi-Fi, click on the yellow Download Now button to get instructions for transferring the book to your Kindle via USB.
9. If the book does not show up, go to the menu on your Kindle and choose sync.

Return an eBook early

1. Go to amazon.com and sign into your Amazon account. Hover over **Your Account** and in the menu that appears click on **Manage Your Content and Devices**.
2. From the **Actions** menu next to the book you would like to return, choose **Return this book**.
