

Read Library eBooks on your Nook

You will need

- A computer or laptop
- A USB cord and your Nook
- Your library card

Steps

1. Download the free Adobe Digital Editions software onto your computer or laptop from **adobe.com** (search for Digital Editions).
2. If you don't have an Adobe ID, create one at **adobe.com**. Click on **Sign In** and then click **Get an Adobe ID**.
3. Once you have an Adobe ID, go to **ffpubliclibrary.org/digital** and click on **OverDrive Media Console**.
4. When you find a title that you want to check out, click on the book cover and then **Borrow**. If it says **Place a Hold**, all copies are checked out. You can place a hold on the item and be notified by email when it is ready.
5. If prompted, sign into your account and then click **Borrow** again.
6. Go to **My Account** and then select **Checkouts**. Next to the book click **Choose a Format** and select **EPUB Book**.
7. Save the book and then open the downloaded file (it will be an acsm file).
8. The book will open in Adobe Digital Editions. Sign in using your Adobe ID.
9. Click on **Library**.
10. Connect your Nook to the computer with the USB cord. **Nook** will be listed under Devices on the left side of Adobe Digital Editions.
11. Click on the book you just downloaded and drag it to the **Nook** icon. This will transfer it to your Nook.
12. Enjoy your new eBook!

Return an eBook early

1. Open Adobe Digital Editions on your computer and right click on the book.
2. Choose **Return Borrowed Item**.
