

# Borrow Digital Books, Movies & Music with Your Library Card!



## Hoopla: videos, music, ebooks, audiobooks & comics

NEW

*No waiting. No late fees. Borrow up to 4 items per month.*

*Checkout periods: videos=2-3 days; music=1 week; ebooks, audiobooks & comics=3 weeks*

1. Download the Hoopla app or go to [hoopladigital.com](http://hoopladigital.com).
2. Create an account with your email. When prompted, select Fergus Falls Public Library and enter your library barcode number.



## Libby by Overdrive: ebooks and audiobooks

*No monthly limits. 5 books at time. Place a hold on items already checked out.*

*Checkout period: up to 3 weeks*

### Libby on a smartphone or tablet:

1. Download the free **Libby**, by Overdrive app from your device's app store. *(Alternatively, you can use the old Overdrive app).*
2. Open the Libby app. Tap **Hi!** then **Find My Library**.
3. Sign in with your library card when prompted.
4. Search for eBooks and audiobooks to check out. When you find a title that you want to check out, tap **Borrow** then **Borrow!** If it says **Place a Hold**, all copies are checked out. You can place a hold on the item and be notified by email when it is ready.

Tap **Shelf** along the bottom of the screen to see your downloaded books and audiobooks. Tap the **book cover** in the circle to return to your last opened book. Tap **Library** to check out more books.

To return an item early: Go to the **Shelf**. Tap on the book cover. Tap **Return Title to Library** then **Return!**

### Libby on a computer:

1. Go to [ffpubliclibrary.org/digital](http://ffpubliclibrary.org/digital) and click **Download eBooks and Audiobooks**.
2. When you find a title that you want to check out, click on the book cover and then **Borrow**. If it says **Place a Hold**, all copies are checked out. You can place a hold on the item and be notified by email when it is ready.
3. Click **Go to Loans** or go to **My Account** then **Loans**. Next to the book, choose to download the book or read it in your browser.

## Overdrive on a Kindle Fire:

**use this instead of Libby**

1. Download the free **OverDrive** app from your device's app store.
2. Open the **OverDrive** app. Tap **Sign up** and **Sign up Using Library Card**.
3. Tap **Add a Title** to search for eBooks and audiobooks to check out. When you find a book that you want to check out, tap **Borrow**. If it says **Place a Hold**, all copies are checked out. You can place a hold on the item and be notified by email when it is ready.
4. Tap **Go to Loans** or go to **My Account** then **Loans**.
5. Tap **Download EPUB eBook**.
6. Tap on the **menu** icon  and select **Bookshelf** to see your books and audiobooks.
7. You can start to enjoy your new eBook or audiobook by tapping on the book cover.

## Libby on a black and white Kindle:

### If you use the Libby app on a smartphone or tablet: (if not, skip to below)

1. Check out a book on the Libby app, then **go to Shelf**, tap the book cover and select **Send to Device**.
2. Tap **select your device** and choose your **Kindle**. Then tap **Send to Kindle!**
3. This opens Amazon. If necessary, sign in to your Amazon account. Choose the Kindle you would like the book delivered to and tap **Get Library Book**.
4. If your Kindle is connected to Wi-Fi, the book will automatically download.
5. If your Kindle is not connected to Wi-Fi, click on the yellow Download Now button to get instructions for transferring the book to your Kindle via USB.
6. If the book does not show up, go to the menu on your Kindle and choose sync.

**OR**

1. On your computer or mobile device, go to **amazon.com** and sign into your account.
2. Go to **ffpubliclibrary.org/digital** and click **Download eBooks and Audiobooks**.
3. When you find a title that you want to check out, click on the book cover and then **Borrow**. If it says **Place a Hold**, all copies are checked out. You can place a hold on the item and be notified by email when it is ready.
4. If prompted, sign into your account.
5. Click **Go to Loans** or go to **My Account** then **Loans**.
6. Next to the book click **Read now with Kindle**.
7. This opens Amazon. If necessary, sign in to your Amazon account. Choose the Kindle you would like the book delivered to and tap **Get Library Book**.
